If however any applications are **withdrawn**, or if the application is rejected by the Council and the applicant informs the Secretary that he/she does **not intend to renew** the application, a **refund** shall be made of **one half of the fee paid**.

- A. When a plan is amended or not approved, the old plan must be withdrawn, and a 50% refund must be made. The amended plan fee is R 12.63/ m².
- B. There is no minimum fee (except for walls and fences). The R 12.63/ m² applies in all other cases.
- C. Only the five inspections are covered by the plan fee. For any other inspections, a R227.47 fee is payable.
- D. Where there is a "change of usage" e.g.: toilet converted to shower garage to TV room etc. the R 12.63/m² will apply.

- 4. Any rates that are not paid on the due date will be subject to interest at the rate of 1% per month or part thereof.
- 5. Collection charges will levied on any outstanding debt at the end of June 2021 at 10%.
